I am just in receipt of the Los Angeles Times' Pleadings and Exhibits.

David questioned me about the Licciardello deposition and the issue of the possible breach of the Release if persons with knowledge, outside of attorneys, staff persons in law offices and TBN disseminated allegations or facts regarding the Lonnie Ford claims and assertions.

There is one situation that came to my mind after our conversation concluded, which I feel that I should relate to you, to wit:

1. As you are probably aware, a year or so after I separated from the firm, David Middlebrook's wife sued him for divorce and went to the District Attorney and claimed that he had molested their son or sons and


